She saw first hand how hard it was for her mother to keep up the monthly bills. Nyche knew early on that education was important. Nyche participated in the Parks department after school programs while living here in the Parkview neighborhood. Nyche completed High School. Then, unexpectedly Nyche found herself preparing to have a baby of her own. This only made her set long term goals and she vowed to work hard. After joining FSS Nyche enrolled at Jefferson County Technical College (JCTC) and was able to successfully complete a Medical Records Certificate class.
